PRODUCT

**RADICCHIO ROSSO DI TREVISO "TARDIVO" ("LATE")**

**appearance:** regular, uniform buds endowed with good consistence; closed leaves, wrapping up which tend to close the bunch in the apex part; bunch provided with part of root perfectly cleaned and with length proportional to bunch size, anyway no longer than 6 cm;

**colour:** leaf limb is intense winey red coloured with secondary veins hardly signed; dorsal rib (main vein) is white;

**taste:** dorsal rib with agreeably bitterish taste and crackling in consistency;

**caliber:** (of bunches) 100 gr. minimum weight, 3 cm minimum diameter at collar, 12-25 cm length (without taproot);

**season:** from November to April/May;

**RADICCHIO ROSSO DI TREVISO "PRECOCE" ("EARLY")**

**appearance:** voluminous, lengthened, well closed, endowed with modest part of root;

**colour:** leaves characterized by a very signed main vein, white coloured which branches out in many small nervations in the deep red of the leaf edge considerably developed;

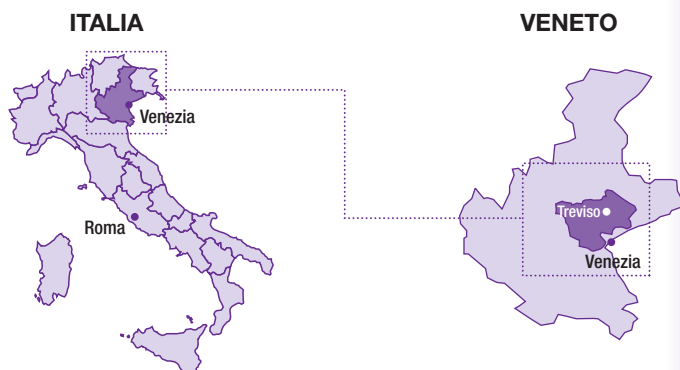
**taste:** leaves with lightly bitterish taste and of medium crackling consistency;

**caliber:** (of bunches) 150 gr minimum weight, 15-25 cm length (without root);

**season:** from September to November/December.

PRODUCTION ZONE

The area of production, transformation and packing of the Radicchio Rosso di Treviso PGI (PGI - Protected Geographical Indication) of "tardivo" (late) type included the whole territory of the Communes of Carbonera, Casale sul Sile, Casier, Istrana, Mogliano Veneto, Morgano, Paese, Ponzano Veneto, Preganziol, Quinto di Treviso, Silea, Spresiano, Trevignano, Treviso, Vedelago, Villorba, Zero Branco in province of Treviso; of Piombino Dese and Trebaseleghe in province of Padova; of Martellago, Mirano, Noale, Salzano and Scorze in province of Venice. The area of production, transformation and packing of the Radicchio Rosso di Treviso PGI (PGI) of "Precoce" (early) type includes the whole territory of Communes of Breda di Piave, Carbonera, Casale sul Sile, Casier, Castelfranco Veneto, Castello di Godego, Istrana, Loria, Maserada, Mogliano Veneto, Monastier, Morgano, Paese, Ponzano Veneto, Preganziol, Quinto di Treviso, Resana, Riese Pio X, Roncade, San Biagio di Callalta, Silea, Spresiano, Trevignano, Treviso, Vedelago, Villorba, Zenson di Piave and Zero Branco in province of Treviso; of Borgoricco, Camposampiero, Loreggia, Massanzago, Piombino Dese e Trebaseleghe in province of Padova; of Martellago, Mirano, Noale, Salzano, S. Maria di Sala, Scorzé and Spinea in province of Venice.



DENOMINATION MARK



The logo, red coloured, on white background, consists of a stylized composition of red chicories over which dominates the inscription "Radicchio Rosso di Treviso PGI", all squared by a red outline.

On each container and/or on the sealing cover the PGI identifying logo has to be put, specifying as well the typology "Precoce" (early) or "Tardivo" (late). Every lot is identifiable through the number and code of the packer.
